WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

WHO FILES A WHISTLEBLOWER CLAIM?

You might have grounds to file a whistleblower claim if you have witnessed the following:

CORRUPTION

fraud, embezzlement, kickbacks, bribes

BUSINESS FRAUD

price fixing, overbilling, billing for services not performed, tax fraud

EDUCATION FRAUD

false accreditations, paying recruiters for enrolling students, falsifying student records, student loan fraud

GOVERNMENT FRAUD

contractor price fixing, double billing, overcharging, selling defective products, billing for services not performed

MILITARY CONTRACTOR FRAUD

kickbacks to military or government officials, selling defective products, bribes, double billing

WHY FILE A WHISTLEBLOWER CLAIM?

Waste and fraud cost American taxpayers

MILLIONS OF DOLLARS

EACH YEAR

Government and military corruption can put **LIVES AT STAKE**

YOU - and not the person or company that broke the law - **MAY BE PROSECUTED FOR FAILING TO REPORT FRAUD OR CORRUPTION**

WHISTLEBLOWERS ARE PROTECTED

from wrongful termination, harrasment & discrimination under federal law

ENTITLED TO FINANCIAL COMPENSATION

HOW ARE WHISTLEBLOWERS PROTECTED?

Employees who expose an employer's fraudulent acts are

PROTECTED UNDER SECTION 3730(h) OF THE FALSE CLAIM ACT

known as "Whistleblower Protection Provisions."

QUI TAM

under the False Claims Act, allows people with evidence of fraud against federal programs to file a lawsuit on behalf of the United States government.

Employees who are **DISCHARGED, DEMOTED, HARASSED, OR DISCRIMINATED AGAINST** for exposing corruption may be entitled to

REINSTATMENT | BACKPAY | COMPENSATION FOR LITIGATION COSTS | MONETARY AWARDS FOR EXPOSING OR REPORTING CERTAIN TYPES OF FRAUD

TAKE A STAND AGAINST CORRUPTION
